CHAPTER WEBSITE COMPETITION

The purpose of this event is to encourage FFA Chapters to develop a proficiency in the creation and design of websites.

ELIGIBILITY

Each Chapter of the Southern Region may enter a website. The chapter website must be developed and maintained by current FFA members of the Chapter entering the contest.

PROCEDURE

1. Design a Chapter website with chapter members, school personnel, parents, boosters clubs, business professionals, and community members as the target audience. If web space is needed for a chapter website, space may obtain through the Southern Region FFA website: www.srffa.org
2. The presentation should include elements such as page layout, navigational scheme, graphics/ multimedia use, and site content.
3. Chapters must complete the entry form on the following page. The URL must be typed or the site will not be judged.
4. **The website must be available for viewing on the Internet at the time of judging or the site will not be judged.** No changes can be made to the website after the official entry deadline. Judging of the website will take place during the week of March 14, 2017. Results will be announced at the Southern Region Meeting on April 8, 2017.
5. Websites should be designed to allow for viewing by as many different browsers as possible (Internet Explorer, Netscape, etc.)

JUDGING

1. Using the score card, a panel of judges selects the winners. Each judge will total the score for each website. Websites shall be ranked in numerical order on basis of final score to be determined by each judge without consultation with each other. The judges' ranking of each website then shall be added and the winner will be the website whose total of rankings is the lowest. Other placing shall be determined in the same manner. (Low point score method of selection).
