Contest Scoring

1. 50 items will be selected for identification from the list attached to these rules. Breakdown of selection of items is as follows: 30 plants, 20 tools & materials (4 points for each correct answers. 200 points possible)

2. Three Judging classes: One class of bedding plants, trees, and one shrubs class. (50 points per class, 150 points possible)

3. Transplanting demonstration according to the curricular code. See below. (50 points possible)

4. No Reasons will be given on judging classes

5. Transplanting
 - A. Contestants will transplant one liner to a 1 gallon container, which will be worth 50 points: 25 points for the mechanics and 25 points for the explanation of the process to a judge. A ten (10) point deduction will be made if the explanation exceeds three (3) minutes.

Transplant Score Card Value

Mechanics

1. Checking soil for moisture 5pts.
2. Removing liner from pot 5pts.
3. Centering plant in can 5pts
4. Proper level of plant/soil level 5pts.
5. Watering the transplanted liner 5pts.

Explanation of Process. Explanation of the quality of the liner and the steps outlined in the mechanics of the process. 25pts.
